



St Mellion Golf Guidelines

Every effort is made to ensure a reasonable pace and standard of play. To achieve this where possible our policy is to pair up all groups into 4-balls. (1,2 or 3-Balls do not have priority)

Please would all groups only call through a faster group if there is room to play into. To assist speed of play we encourage any player to play a provisional rather than walk back to the tee.

Speed of Play - The following is an indication of the time four-balls are expected to be completed on each course: Kernow Course 4 Hours & Nicklaus Course: 4 3/4 Hours

Players are expected at all times to be aware of danger to others and to themselves. All accidents MUST be reported.

It is the responsibility of all players to ensure they are adequately insured to cover whatever may arise.

All buggies must be operated in accordance with our Golf Buggy guidelines which are on all disclaimers.

It is required that NO trolleys are taken on to teeing areas or between bunkers and the putting surface.

During inclement weather the course will be closed if it is deemed unfit or unsafe for play. Crown Golf have a policy for lightening and fog which are on display on this notice-board.

St Mellion Dress Standards

All golfers are kindly requested to observe the following dress code

Correct golf footwear

Shirts with collars (mock-necks allowed) & must be tucked in

Tailored shorts & trousers only (No cargo or side pockets)

No Denim, tracksuits or leisure leggings

No ¾ length trousers

No tucking trousers into socks

Caps to be worn in the correct manner

No bandanas

(No headwear to be worn in the bar/restaurant areas)

St Mellion staff have the final decision as to suitability of clothing and footwear

Additional for Ladies only:

Tapered shirts can be worn out

Capri ¾ length trousers acceptable
